

## **Deibert Finishes 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Callaway Golf Assistant PGA Championship**

After a successful 2010 season, a season in which he captured his first Haverford Trust Company Player of the Year title, Travis Deibert (Commonwealth National GC) had one more event to compete in before wrapping up his tournament season.

By finishing in a tie for second place at this past summer's Philadelphia Section Callaway Golf Assistant PGA Championship, Deibert earned a berth in the national championship. Fellow Philadelphia Section Assistant PGA Professionals Richie Krebs (Hanover GC), Billy Mullen (Jeffersonville GC), and Chris Wisler (Wild Quail G & CC) also joined Deibert at the national championship.

Deibert carded consecutive rounds of 1-under par 71 to kick-off the Championship on Thursday and Friday, however Deibert really came to life on the weekend. On day three, Deibert paired five birdies against two bogies to finish the third round at 3-under par 69. Deibert ended his round by making three straight birdies on holes 16, 17, and 18. With his Saturday charge, Deibert found himself just three shots back of the leader.

Unfortunately for Deibert, despite firing his best round on day four, a 4-under par 68, he was only able to make up one shot on eventual champion Frank Bensel. Deibert's four-day total of 9-under par 279 was good enough for a solo second place finish. Additionally, Billy Mullen and Chris Wisler were also on hand through the weekend and finished in 33<sup>rd</sup> and 40<sup>th</sup> place respectively.
