After rain canceled the first event of 2010 season, the Section finally kicked off tournament play on April 13<sup>th</sup> with the Callaway Golf TPD Championship at the Philadelphia Cricket Club (Flourtown, PA). The Callaway Golf TPD Championship is an

invitation only event for all members of the Section's Tournament Players Division (TPD). The modified Stableford event awarded points based on the players score in relationship to par. Richie Krebs, Assistant PGA Professional, Hanover CC (Abbottstown, PA), turned five (5) birdies and no other mark worse than a bogey into 21 points, which was good enough for a one (1)-point victory in the season's first point's event of the year. With his victory, Krebs took home 140 points and the early lead in The Haverford Trust Company Player of the Year Standings.

In the senior division, Greg Farrow, Deerwood CC (Westhampton, NJ) out dueled both George Forster, Radnor Valley CC (Villanova, PA) and Bob Lennon, Wilmington CC (Wilmington, DE), finishing two (2)-points ahead of the pair. The victory puts Farrow on top of the Robert "Skee" Riegel Senior Player of the Year standings with 120 points.
