

ARTICLE II – SECTION BY-LAWS SUBORDINATE TO NATIONAL CONSTITUTION

Section 2.01. Scope of By-Laws. The scope of these By-Laws is intended to encompass, but not exceed, that the area of jurisdiction granted the Section by its parent body, The Professional Golfers' Association of America. The Section's Articles and By-Laws will in no way conflict with those of that National body, and any situation not covered by these By-Laws, including its Code of Ethics, shall be de facto parts of this document and shall supersede and give clarity to these articles and sections.

Section 2.02. Assessments on Members. The Board of Directors may fix and levy dues to assess members for any lawful purpose, in amounts per classification and fix the time of payment by thirty (30) days notice setting forth the amount and reason. The Board of Directors may make regulations necessary to enforce the collection of such dues or assessments, including provisions for the termination of membership, upon notice, for nonpayment of such dues or assessments, and for reinstatement of membership.
