

**Section 14.01 Robert “Skee” Riegel Senior POY Major Point Tournament Criteria**

The Robert “Skee” Reigel Senior Player of the Year Award is given each year to the player who has amassed the largest number of points through his play in a given season. In order to be eligible for this award, contestants must meet the following criteria:

- I. Must be a Philadelphia Section PGA Member or Apprentice 50 years or older
- II. Must be eligibly employed within the Philadelphia Section
- III. Must be in good standing with the PGA of America

The Tournament Committee shall determine the list of official Major Tournaments prior to the season using the following criteria:

- (A) Major Events: Open exclusively to all Philadelphia Section PGA Members, Apprentices, and Pre-Apprentices that are 50 years or older.
  - (I) Any “Invitational” or other event designated by the Tournament Committee, which is open to a minimum of seventy-five Philadelphia Members, Apprentices and Pre-Apprentices, or
  - (II) Any “Invitational” or other event designated by the Tournament Committee, in which a minimum of twenty Philadelphia Members, Apprentices and Pre-Apprentices receive invitations according to the current or prior years Player of the Year Points standing.
  
- (B) Championships of the Philadelphia Section PGA and other allied golf associations including GAP, NJSGA, PSGA and DSGA.
  
- (C) Northern, Southern, Eastern and Western Bonus Tournaments suggested criteria:
  - (III) Events with purses exceeding \$20,000
  - (IV) Annual repeating tournaments
  - (V) Tournaments with strong field strengths
  - (VI) Multiple round tournaments
  - (VII) Individual scores only (not a team competition).
