

#### **Section 4.02 Apprentices**

Philadelphia Section PGA apprentices in good standing will be permitted to play in Section tournaments and may join the Tournament Players Division of the Philadelphia Section PGA upon payment of the annual TPD dues, provided they meet the qualifications outlined below.

- (i) Successful completion of the PGA Playing Ability Test Proper
  - (ii) Registration in the PGA/PGM Program.
  
- (b) **Unemployed Apprentices**  
Registered Apprentices becoming unemployed during the tournament season are entitled to play in Sectional events defined in Note 1 above for a period of thirty (30) days from their last date of employment, after which playing privileges will be suspended. Playing privileges will be reinstated upon becoming employed in a capacity that would entitle the Apprentice to again receive credits towards membership. Apprentices who become unemployed after paying TPD dues and who do not become employed again during the tournament season are eligible for a pro-rated rebate of their TPD dues.
  
- (c) **Suspended Apprentices**  
Apprentices who become suspended under any circumstance will not be eligible for participation in any Section events.
