



Lookaway's Mike Little Wins the Radley Run Classic

West Chester, P.A. – On Monday, June 12, Radley Run Country Club played host to the Radley Run Classic, the season's seventh point's event in the race for the PAO Player of the Year. The Radley Run Classic was played as an 18 hole individual stroke play event featuring 29 local PGA Assistant Professionals.

Competitors faced hot temperatures nearing 95 degrees along with high humidity bringing the chance of an afternoon thunderstorm. Fortunately the field was sent out in twosomes to fly around and ensure the entire field would complete the event. Brett Melton (Radley Run Country Club) the host assistant professional was certainly the favorite entering this event as he is currently in second place for the PAO Player of the Year and third in the race for the Omega Player of the Year presented by Haverford Trust. Melton carded five bogeys on his outward nine but rallied back with five birdies on the day to post the lead in the clubhouse at even par (72). Melton's lead would soon be tied as Sam Ambrose (Aronimink Golf Club) posted two birdies on his first seven holes to reach red figures before two bogeys dropped him back to even par for the tournament.

It looked as though even par would hold up on a day with tough conditions. However, Mike Little (Lookaway Golf Club) would finally post the first and only score under par. Little carded three bogeys and one birdie on his outward nine to make the turn at 2 over par (38). Little made his charge on the back nine making birdies at 12, 16, and 18 to post 1-under par (71). This was his second win of the PAO season and helped to increase his lead in the PAO Player of the Year over Brett Melton.
