Philadelphia PGA to Revamp Member Communications

The biggest communication change you notice is the unveiling of a new Philadelphia PGA website. Although the site name, <u>www.phillypga.com</u>, will remain the same, the functionality and ease of use will improve. It is our hope that with this new website we will be better equipped to



showcase our members, facilities and programs. The website will go live in the coming days.

The second area in which you will see a change is the Section's digital newsletter. We have reformatted the newsletter to include more relevant information.
