 TEN (10) national education programs/workshops (to include PGA PGM) or sectional education programs/workshops
 within the last TEN (10) years.

- Candidate must have maintained a continual record of service, promotion of the game of golf, as well as proven interest and ability to provide opportunities and experiences for youth to learn, play and participate in the game.

- Candidate must have maintained a continual record of service, promotion of the game of golf and proven interest and ability to provide opportunities and experiences for military personnel to learn, play and participate in the game.
