

John Rogers – Bio

In 2017, John Rogers enters into his 25th year as a Class A member of the PGA of America.

Rogers has served as the Section's Director of Section Affairs, the Section's Secretary, and currently as its Vice President. He has also been the President of the Central Counties Chapter from 2005 to 2007.

Rogers began his golfing career as an assistant golf professional at the Lancaster Host Farm, The Chambersburg Country Club, and The Country Club of York.

In 1989, Rogers landed his first head professional position at the Lake Holiday Country Club in Cross Junction, Va in the MAPGA. In 1993, he returned to the Philadelphia Section as the head professional at The Magestic Ridge Golf Club in Chambersburg, Pa. After his 20 year stint at Majestic Ridge, Rogers joined the EZGO Company in central Pennsylvania as the territory manager. Currently, Rogers is the Director of Sales for the Victory Golf Pass and the Vice President of the Victory Golf Foundation.

In 2011, Rogers received the National PGA Horton Smith Award becoming only the 11th individual from the Philadelphia PGA to be named as a national award winner. He has served the PGA of America as a committee member on the National Education Committee, National Hall of Fame Committee, and the National Special Awards Committee. Other awards Rogers received include Central Counties Chapter's Golf Professional of the Year in 2003, the Philadelphia Section's Horton Smith Award winner in 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2009, and 2010.

In addition to his awards, Rogers has been the Section's Education Chairperson for 12 consecutive years from 1999 to 2010.

Rogers has been married to wife, Chris, for the last 29 years and together raised three children: Kyle, Taylor and Molly. Rogers and his family reside in Chambersburg, Pa.
