PGA HOPE

PGA H.O.P.E (<u>Helping Our Patriots Everywhere</u>) is the PGA of America's flagship military program, introducing weekly golf clinics to Veterans with disabilities to enhance their physical, mental, social and emotional well-being. Golf has become a therapeutic part of the rehabilitation process for many Veterans with disabilities, and PGA HOPE is truly making a difference. PGA REACH Philadelphia works with facilities and VA hospitals to identify golf courses and communities to host the six-week program, which is led by trained PGA Professionals that provide Veterans with golf instruction, course access, and adaptive equipment as needed. Locally, the Philadelphia HOPE program has served over 150 Veterans through our 3 Chapters in Bensalem, PA, Marlton, NJ and Harrisburg, PA in 2019.

College Connection Program

2019 was our sixth year for the College Connection Program and we are looking to grow even more next year by reaching out to alumni organizations for additional funding. The program is for Villanova Business School students and includes 4 Get Golf Ready sessions at local facilities. The program emphasizes the business and networking connections that the game of golf provides. In 2019, we had 35 business students enrolled in the program at host facilities in our area. We would like to thank the Head Professionals and the staff from Philadelphia Country Club (Scott Reilly) and Llanerch Country Club (Chris Wilkinson) for their time and support in hosting this program.

Golf in Schools Program

Our Golf in Schools program has seen a great amount of support and interest from local area schools and administrators. We have partnered with the Golf Association of Philadelphia and together we use SNAG golf to introduce physical education teachers to the curriculum so they can incorporate it into their class schedules. The program was in at least 25 different schools/districts in 2019. We are supporting this program through our PGA REACH Philadelphia foundation by funding the program to local schools that participate. Our goal is to continue to grow the program by adding new schools each year. We also have plans to enhance the program by building an after-school component to the program as a next step for kids that participate. I would like to thank all of our professionals for their time and support of this program.

Facility Meetings & Member Education

The Section's Player Development Director, Leila Mackie, whom everyone should know, has visited over 90 facilities since she arrived in 2013. Leila's facility visits offer insights into PGA player development programs as well as providing guidance and support for new ideas created by you! Leila has a playbook full of topics covering junior golf, women's golf, membership issues, social media concepts, PGA member benefits, as well as gathering feedback from members about the Section's operations. We also invite every one of you to submit a best practice to Leila; it can be about any positive program/idea that you have implemented at your facility. I also encourage and invite EVERY FACILITY to invite Leila for a visit, it is time well spent.

Equipment Rental Program

Did you know that our Section offers equipment rentals for YOUR facility programs? It's true! You can rent Golfzilla, an inflatable hippopotamus, Birdie Ball, SNAG kits, and inflatable nets for your facility programs. Simply contact Courtney Curcio at the Section office to reserve your day and time in advance. Facilities have used the equipment for junior golf camps, family events, member guest tournaments, etc. Over 70 facilities have utilized this program so far and have seen the value it can add to their events. All the rental proceeds go to our PGA REACH Philadelphia foundation. In the past few years the program has raised over \$10,000 for our foundation!

In conclusion, I would like to invite all of you to take advantage of these player development programs and reach out to Leila, myself, or any of the committee members. We are here to be ambassadors for our Section and to help you at your facilities grow the game and increase your bottom line through player development programs.

The Philadelphia Section Junior Tour is pleased to have continued it success with the 2019 season. With 82 Junior Tour events and 12 Drive, Chip and Putt Qualifiers, both local and sub-regional, we are still constantly striving to improve and stay at the fore-front of junior golf. The Philadelphia Junior Tour is always adding new and exciting components to our program. The continuation of AJGA PBE recognized events, nationally ranked JGS events and Junior PGA Championships are an example of the junior tour's success.
